The collaborative Erasmus+ project is implemented by an experienced consortium of seven partners working in adult education, vocational training, counselling and healthcare.

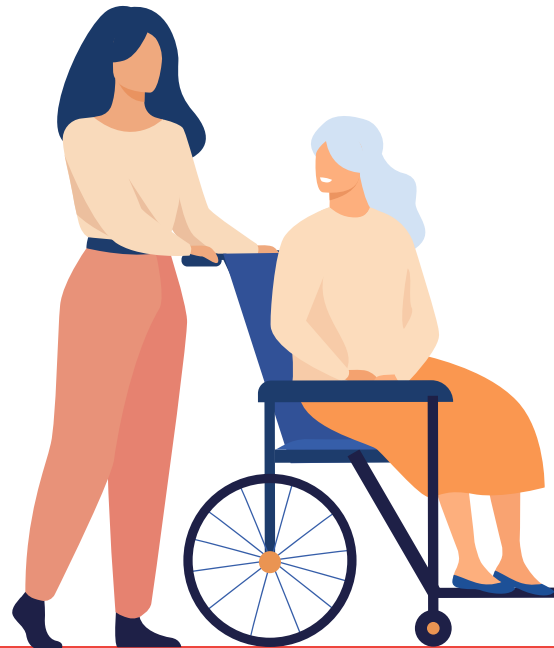
TARGET GROUPS
